ENTRY DEADLINE:

The 12th New England Collective Juried Exhibition is hosted by Galatea Fine Art, a contemporary artist-run gallery in the heart of Boston's SoWa District. Our 41 members include painters, sculptors, photographers and mixed media artists with both emerging and established careers.

THE JUROR:

Leah Triplett Harrington is a curator, writer and editor. As curator for *Now + There Public Art Accelerator*, she facilitates and organizes large-scale public art commissions, most recently *What Do We Have in Common?* by Janet Zweig, *Ambrosia* by Cicely Carew, *The Shape of Play* by Sari Carel, and *¡Provecho!* by Justin Favela. She is also a founding editor of publication and platform *The Rib* and editor-at-large for *Boston Art Review*. Her writing has most recently appeared in those publications as well as *Sculpture*, *Public Art Dialogue*, *Flash Art*, *Hyperallergic*, *WBUR's The Artery*, *Big Red & Shiny* and *The Brooklyn Rail*. As an independent curator, she has organized projects for Boston University Art Galleries, Trestle Gallery, Herter Gallery, and others. In 2021, she was the inaugural curatorial mentor for Praise Shadows Art Gallery and taught in the MFA program in painting at Boston University.

EXHIBITION DATES:

August 5 – 28, 2022

Work must remain on exhibit until 5pm on Sunday, August 28.

RECEPTION:

Friday, August 5, 2022, from 6 – 8 pm

We are looking forward to an in-house reception with lots of attendees, but our plans will depend upon the state COVID restrictions for that date.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists may submit up to TWO original works created within the LAST FIVE years. Work in all media is encouraged. Work shown in previous New England Collective exhibitions may not be submitted again. Any piece that differs significantly from the accepted digital image or is not framed in a suitable manner for museum display will be rejected. All work submitted must be for sale.

FRAMING, INSTALLATIONS & SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

If your work is to hang on the wall, be it framed or not, it must be properly wired on the back. Clip-on frames, saw tooth and keyhole hangers cannot be accommodated. There is a size limit of 50 inches framed width and height.

IMAGE FORMAT:

We will accept only JPEG formatted images. JPEGs must be 1400 pixels (about 19 inches) on the longest side and must have a resolution of 72 dpi. Please name your files this way:

(Example: Letvin_Carolyn_2_Moon of the Harvest.jpg)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Galatea Fine Art will accept EMAIL SUBMISSIONS ONLY. Please read this Prospectus to make sure your work is eligible, is properly wired for hanging, and meets the size requirements.

To enter this show:

- Fill in the Submission Form, corresponding it with your entries. The Submission Form is provided in two formats – a Word doc that is separate from the Prospectus and the third page of the Prospectus PDF. Pick the one that works best for you.
- Email your images and videos, along with your completed Submission Form to: GalateaJuried@gmail.com
- You then make your payment through Paypal as instructed below. We regret that we cannot accept submissions by any other method.

FEE:

\$35.00 covers up to TWO submissions for one artist.

Please note: The New England Collective XII is a competitive, juried exhibition. Submission does not guarantee participation in the show. Submission fees are non-refundable, even if work is not selected.

ARTIST STATEMENT:

If accepted, you will be asked to supply an artist statement that applies to the accepted artwork and a resume for our exhibition notebook.

SALES:

Work sold will have a 30% commission paid to Galatea Fine Art. After the close of the exhibition, artists will receive checks for 70% of the sale price.

SUBMISSION PERIOD:

Submissions will be accepted until midnight, Sunday, July 10, 2022. No late submissions will be accepted.

SELECTED WORK:

Artists will be notified of selected work on July 15 by 5pm on our website: www.galateafineart.com . Please do not call Galatea Fine Art regarding your submission.

DELIVERY OF ART:

Please have all artwork labeled with your name, title of the piece, medium and price. We will be accepting art deliveries on the following three days:

- Friday, July 29, 12 – 4 pm
- Saturday, July 30, 12 – 4 pm
- Sunday, July 31, 12 – 4 pm

SHIPPED WORK:

Your package should arrive any time on or before July 25, 2022.

Work arriving late may not be hung. Please label all artwork with your name, title of piece, price and contact information.

You MUST include a **pre-paid return label** from UPS or FEDEX with your shipment. *We cannot deliver to the U.S. Post Office.* Please use a sturdy box that can be reused for return and do not use peanuts as packing material. *We will not accept work with packing peanuts.* Work arriving damaged will be returned immediately. Please consider this if you decide to use glass. Your work will be returned shortly after show de-installation.

- Monday, August 30, 10:30 am – 2 pm
- Tuesday, August 31, 11 am – 1 pm
